**Deadline for nominations is Wednesday, April 30, 2025.**

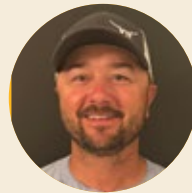
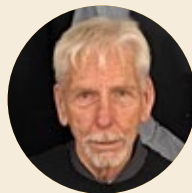
**To be a member of our Board of Directors:**
